Did you know that Art Education increases the likelihood that your child or grandchild will graduate high school and matriculate into higher education? The increase is 84%! That's huge! Art Education also helps your children to develop problem solving and critical thinking skills. It increases test scores and helps kids retain information better. Now I'm not saving vou're not going to have to tell your child to clean their room

100 times, but maybe they'll retain it after the 50th time you say it? Truly it improves their ability to retain vocabulary and understand abstract concepts in Algebra and Literature much better, and with Science and Math they're able to understand higher concepts and come up with new ideas to apply their knowledge. Governor Nathan Deal has made a challenge to our schools to turn STEM initiatives into STEAM and let the students focus on creative thinking to problem solve.
